- 6. Please tell your story of "Why **you** give to the Foundation?
- 7. Tell the audience that later in the Summit, we hope to hear stories about Polio and Rotary's work to eradicate this crippling disease. (Please do not give any statistics about Polio Eradication. However, it would be good note that there is information about Rotary's number one priority, the eradication of Polio, in the toolkits provided to everyone in attendance today.)
- 8. Please call on 2 Rotarians to briefly tell their stories of ~"Why they give to the Foundation?" If possible, contact Rotarians before the ORS who have a powerful story and ask them to be prepared to "tell their stories" in one or two minutes! Another option is to have someone who is passionate about grants share the results of a successful grant that had a huge impact on saving lives in two or three minutes!
