Congratulations to drawing winner **MOLLY HERRINGTON**, the District Grants Subcommittee Chair from District 5580 in Bismarck, ND!


Molly's name was chosen from the 224 Rotarians and Rotaractors who were fully registered for the 2022 North Star Institute as of August 7th.

**Sue Abderholden** has devoted her career to changing laws and attitudes that affect people with disabilities and their families. Since the fall of 2001, she has served as the **Executive Director for NAMI Minnesota** (National Alliance on Mental Illness). She has held leadership positions with Arc of Minnesota, U.S. Senator Paul D. Wellstone and PACER Center. Sue has a B.A. in political

science from Macalester College and a master's degree in public health administration from the University of Minnesota.

Ms. Abderholden has received numerous awards for her advocacy including the 2020 Esther Wattenberg Policy Award, being named one of the 100 most influential health care leaders by MN Physician, the 2018 Rona and Ken Purdy Award to End Discrimination from National NAMI, Excellence in Mental Health Advocacy and Policy Award from the International African Mental Health Providers, 2013 Gaylord Anderson Leadership Award from the U of M School of Public Health and the National Council for Behavioral Health 2013 Advocacy Leadership Award.
