You might wear a kilt or a tartan, if you have one.

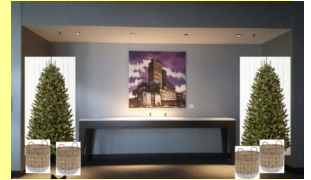
Saturday night is cocktail
